Equipment & Stationery

Pupils joining the Senior School should have a fully equipped pencil containing writing pens, pencils, rubber, colouring pencils, pencil sharpener, highlighter, 15cm and 30cm rulers, glue stick, scissors, protractor, compass and a scientific

calculator (this will be used more as a child progresses through the school and we recommend a Casio FX-85 GTX Scientific Calculator).

All Senior School pupils are issued with an iPad (Gen6 to Gen8) to use during their time at Embley. Though the iPad remains the property of the school, a pupil will be able to take it home and operate it as if it were his/her own. Please provide a compatible stylus and earphones that your son/daughter can use with the iPad.

Blazer Policy

- Blazers will be worn to and from school and lessons, in assemblies, meetings and representing the school.
- Senior School pupils will not be allowed to wear their blazers in the dining hall at lunch or outside during break and lunch time play.
- All pupils will be asked to remove their blazers for practical lessons such as Art, Design Technology and Science or during messy/outdoor activities.
- Pupils will be able to leave their blazers on the back of their chairs if they are warm in class.

Appearance

- Boys and girls in Years 7-11 are required to wear school uniform and an appropriate professional appearance is expected at all times.
- Shirts and blouses should be tucked into trousers and skirts.
- The top button of boys' shirts should be done up at all times and ties should be neatly tied and of an appropriate length.
- No jewellery may be worn in Years 7 to 11 except for one pair of small plain ear studs for girls.
- One discrete religious symbol can be worn but may have to be removed during Games and PE lessons.
- Make-up should not be worn by pupils in Years 7 to 9. For Years 10 and 11, discrete make-up (i.e. light foundation and mascara) may be worn.
- Girls with long hair should have it tied back in practical and Science lessons.
- Boys' hair should not be clipped below grade three and should be above the collar line and tidy if long. Hair should not be unnaturally coloured. There should be no excessive application of gel or similar.
- Boys should be clean shaven.
- There must be no visible tattoos.
- Shoes must be clean and polished regularly. Boots, flimsy pumps, canvas shoes, trainers, platform shoes and stilettos must not be worn. Heels on shoes must not be higher than 5cm.
