



Sixth Form Dress Code & Equipment

Our Sixth Form dress code is smart business attire and we expect all Year 12 and 13 students to meet the professional business wear expectations as follows:

Boys' Dress Code & Appearance

Jacket and trousers	Business suit or blazer and tailored trousers (students are expected to wear a jacket when moving around the site and in the dining hall). No denim materials.
Shirt	Collared with tie.
Jumper	A plain pullover, may be worn under a blazer but shirt and tie should be visible.
Shoes	Smart, practical, clean shoes (no trainers or casual footwear).

Hair should not be clipped below grade three and should be above the collar line and tidy if long. Hair should not be unnaturally coloured. Facial hair is acceptable, providing it is neat and tidy. No facial piercings are acceptable and there must be no visible tattoos.

Girls' Dress Code & Appearance

Business suit	Trousers, skirt or dress suit – the skirt/dress should sit on or just above the knee (students are expected to wear a jacket when moving around the site and in the dining hall). No denim materials or leggings/jeggings.
Tops	Shirt, blouse or smart top (no cropped, low cut, strappy tops, t-shirts or translucent clothing).
Jumper	A plain pullover.
Shoes	Smart, practical, clean shoes (no trainers or casual footwear).

Make-up should be subtle and jewellery should not be excessive or a risk to the student's health and safety within the school environment. No facial piercings are acceptable and there must be no visible tattoos.

These guidelines may be relaxed for special events e.g. trips or non-uniform days. However, shorts and low cut/cropped tops are not appropriate. In extreme weather, students should continue to dress appropriately for a professional environment but further guidelines will be issued appropriate to the weather conditions, for example excessively cold or hot spells.

Students who dress inappropriately will be required to attend a uniform check with the Assistant Head Pastoral and reminded of the guidelines. Students who fail to comply with these guidelines may be asked to return home to change into something more suitable. If students or their parents have any doubt as to whether an item of clothing is suitable for school, they should consult the Director of Sixth Form.

Our school uniform is supplied by Schoolblazer (www.schoolblazer.com) who offer a secure online ordering service which allows you to shop for all uniform and sportswear, using their intelligent sizing service, at your convenience. Please ensure that all items of uniform are clearly labelled. Schoolblazer provides nametag application free of charge. Items marked with * can only be bought from Schoolblazer.

Students who are selected to represent the school at fixtures will be required to buy the team (Games) kit for the relevant sport. Our Sports Department will provide guidance on this when the additional kit is required.
