Embley aims to create an environment in which each individual student, whatever their ability, is encouraged to be academically ambitious and to perform up to and beyond their potential.

Embley uses a variety of internal and external assessments to inform teaching and learning. These assessments are intended to facilitate student progress and the evaluation of that progress against national norms. We are delighted to announce the following exam results for 2021:

# Key Stage 1 and 2:

At Embley's Prep School pupils are assessed each term using Rising Stars Progress in Understanding Mathematics Assessment (PUMA) and Progress in Reading Assessment (PiRA). These termly assessments produce standardised results and age-related scores to enable us to track pupil progress term by term, predict future performance and benchmark against national averages. At Embley we also use CAT data (Y3 & 5) and teacher assessments alongside the more formal PUMA and PIRA together these assessments help us track and monitor progress and potential.
